**ADDENDUM 2 for:**

**Bid No. 18-0090-4 TOM TRIPLETT PARK IMPROVEMENTS - PHASE IV**

**QUESTIONS RECEIVED:**

**1. Q) The detail for “Asphalt Pavement Section” on sheet C3.13 has a 6” GAB layer, Prime Coat, and 2” of 12.5mm SP Asphalt. Should the cost for “Prime Coat” be included in the base stone price?**

*A) Yes, the cost for the prime coat should be included in the bid price for 6” Compacted Granite Aggregate Base Course, Inc. Matl.*

**2.Q) Are we to assume that no work will be performed within Alternates 3,4,6, & 8 except for the infield of Alternate #6 where the multipurpose field and raised stage are located?**

*A) Please refer to sheet G1.4 for the bid phases. Alternates 3, 4, 5, 6, and 8 as specified in the special conditions will not be a part of this bid. The multipurpose field is a part of the base bid. The raised stage is alternate number 5 and is not a part of this bid.*

**3.Q) Is any of the asphalt path along the main roadway on sheets C3.3 and C3.4 included in the base bid? If so, where are the limits?**

*A) Please refer to sheet G1.4 for the bid phases. The asphalt path along the roadway on sheets C3.3 and C3.4 is alternate 8 and is not part of this bid. The asphalt path next to the parking lot that goes to the playground is a part of the base bid as can be seen on G1.4 and has a note on C3.4 pointing to it saying “312 SY 8’ ASPHALT PATH SEE DETAIL (BASE BID)”.*


