These instructions appear to override the RFP requirement for the submission of hard copy responses. However, in question #45 in addendum 4 to RFP No. 20-0018-1, the County indicates, "The due date is now April 30, 2002 at 5:00 pm EST and the County would still like to receive five (5) hard copies."

Given that Georgia and many other states are on stay-at-home executive orders through April 30, 2020, due to the COVID-19 pandemic, would the County please reconsider the requirement for hard copies to be delivered by April 30

This is an RFP which has different requirements than bids as referenced above. We are extending the RFP response date until May 15, 2020 which will allow you additional time to submit the 5 hard copies desired by the County in addition to the electronic copy. If you are unable to provide the hard copies, please provide justification and the soonest date you will commit to furnishing the five (5) hard copies.
