ADDENDUM NO. 1 FOR BID NO. 15-0061-3

**PROVIDE AND INSTALL A 60Hz-500Kw DIESEL GENERATOR FOR
CHATHAM COUNTY POLICE ANNEX**

The bid opening date remains July 8, 2015 at 2:00 p.m.

The following questions have been presented;

1. Will a set of as-built drawings be supplied?

Ans: Yes, the drawings will be provided to the awarded contractor.

2. Please confirm if NFPA-110 is a requirement to be met?

Ans. Yes, it is.

3. Please advise if the existing day tank is to be reused or does the price need to include a new tank?

Ans. Yes, please include in the price the cost to replace the day tank.

4. Please confirm that a 4 hour load bank test is required?

Ans. Yes, we are requiring one (1) four (4) hour load bank test.

5. Please confirm that the work can be performed during normal work hours Monday through Friday?

Ans. Yes, our normal operating hours are from 8:00 am to 5:00 pm, Monday through Friday.

6. Please verify that two (2) Notice to Proceeds (NTP) will be supplied?

Ans. The first Notice to Proceed (NTP) will cover the purchasing of the equipment, submittals, approval of submittals and equipment release. The second NTP will cover the work after the equipment is on site and change date is scheduled.

7. In the meeting it was stated that a subcontractor sheet/list will be added to the package. Please confirm that this will be added and the location in the package it needs to be inserted.

Ans. Please see attached form "List of Subcontractors" and place it behind Attachment G.

8. Please confirm that the existing wire feeding from the generator to the ATS is to remain and be reused?

Ans. Yes, the existing feeder wires will be reused.

9. Are permits required?

Ans. Yes, it is the contractor's responsibility to obtain any and all required permits.

10. What is the scope of work regarding the diesel fuel supply? The Fuel tank is freestanding and very large but capacity is still unknown. Does it remain to serve the new generator?

Ans. Yes, the fuel tank has a capacity of approximately 2500 gallons and will remain to serve the new generator.

11. The Transfer switch in our pictures shows an OT 2000 amp model which would be a manual switch, is this to remain to serve the new generator?


Ans. Yes, the transfer switch is an automatic transfer switch and will remain to serve the new generator.

12. The existing generator appears to have a weather protective enclosure with NO sound attenuation. What is required of the new enclosure? Are we to assume that the specified Enclosed-Steel, Weather Protection, w/ExhSys, Res Muffler is all that is required without sound attenuation?

Ans. Yes, the enclosure shall meet all the standards of a NEMA 3r enclosure. Because of the generator's location there is no concern about sound attenuation.
