QUESTIONS RECEIVED:

1. Q) We estimate progression photos of the external/internal construction every 3 weeks for a total of 42 visits for the 30 month duration. Is that in line with the estimations of important milestones from the developers and/or the county?

A) Generally it could be. However, we will not be providing the number of visits limiting ourselves to it. It is a complex building which will be in different stages of construction at any given time. Milestones have been listed in the Scope. Provide as required.

2. Q) Is google drive an approved data management software for the data of progression photos?

A) It could be. A lot will depend on the demonstration of the software, platform and work done on similar construction projects. Please note that this work is not for marketing or PR purposes. It is for detailed construction progress documentation.

3. Q) Will the 2 webcam installation have to be on-site early May? We will sub-contract this part so we want to ensure our dates are correct.

A) Yes

4. Q) We are licensed for up to 2 million dollars for every site of visit of ground and aerial photography. Our plan is to create a navigational 360 photography tour so that individuals can navigate through the construction site and view previous dates. Since our insurance covers each site visit and is not covered for the entire year, how would you like us to submit proof of insurance since we wouldn't have it until site visit dates are confirmed?

A) Firms shall meet the Insurance requirements as listed in the Invitation To Bid document.

5. Q) How long should we anticipate cloud access to the webcam time lapse, photos and exterior/interior photos? For the 30 months of the construction or indefinitely for historical documentation? Airweb Digital plans to dedicate a physical backup hard drive to Bid #. Cloud access is a annual cost and estimated duration of access should be accounted for accurate estimations.

A) Would need Owner access long term/indefinitely. Access for rest of design and construction team not required.
